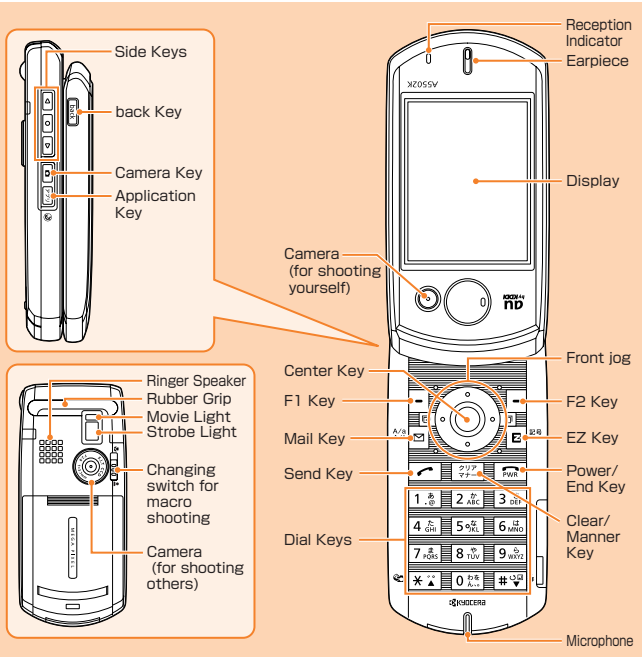

A Simple Manual (English Version)



Turning The A5502K On and Off

- Turning the A5502K On
Press and hold for more than one second.
- Turning the A5502K Off
Press and hold for more than two seconds.

Setting the Date and Time

You can set the phone to display the date and time on the stand-by screen. When this setting is enabled, the A5502K will receive current date and time information for the local service area, and the date and time will be updated accordingly.

From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press ▶ press ▶ press .

Checking Your Own Phone Number and E-mail Address

From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press .

Making / Answering a Call

- Making a Call
From the stand-by screen: enter the phone number you want to call ▶ press .
- To end the call: press or close the phone.

- Answering a Call
Press while the phone is ringing.
To adjust the earpiece volume during a call: press or .

If the phone is closed
Press or open the phone while it is ringing.

Storing an Entry in the Phone Book / Retrieving a Phone Book Entry

- Storing an Entry
From the stand-by screen: press for more than one second ▶ select the item you want to store ▶ press ▶ enter the data ▶ press [完了].
- Retrieving an Entry
From the stand-by screen: press to display the Heading (hiragana row: a, ka, sa, ta, na, ha, ma, ya, ra, wa, or alphabet/other) Search screen ▶ press to select the Heading under which the entry is stored ▶ press to select the appropriate name ▶ press to display the Phone Book Entry details screen.

If the phone is closed
From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press to select [アドレス帳] (Phone Book) ▶ press ▶ press to select the Heading under which the entry is stored ▶ press to display the Name Selection screen ▶ press to select the appropriate name ▶ press to display the Phone Book Entry details screen.

Setting the E-mail and EZweb Default Settings

Before you can begin using the E-mail and EZweb services, you must set the default settings. When you set the default settings, your E-mail address will be registered, allowing you to send and receive E-mails as well as access the Internet.

From the stand-by screen: press , or ▶ set the default settings ▶ press .

Using E-mail and C-mail

- E-mail
To use the E-mail service, you need to subscribe to the EZweb service. If you did not subscribe it when you purchased your phone, please contact au Customer Service Center or au shop for further information. Make sure that you set the default settings before using the E-mail and EZweb services for the first time. (See "Setting the E-mail/EZweb Default Settings" above.)
- Sending an E-mail Message
From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press ▶ press to select the input field ▶ press ▶ press to enter the recipient's address ▶ press ▶ press to select the input field ▶ press to enter the subject ▶ press ▶ press to select the input field ▶ press to enter your message ▶ press ▶ press .
- Reading a Received E-mail Message
When you receive an E-mail message, "新着EメールX件" (X New E-mail), where X represents the number of messages received, will be displayed on the stand-by screen.
From the stand-by screen: press to select [新着Eメール] (New E-mail) ▶ press ▶ press to select [メインフォルダ] (Main folder) ▶ press ▶ press to select the e-mail message you want to read ▶ press .

- C-mail
Subscribers in the Tokyo and Chubu – incorporating Aichi, Gifu, and Mie prefectures – metropolitan areas do not need to subscribe to use this service. For subscribers located outside of these areas, a separate subscription is required.
- Sending a C-mail Message
From the stand-by screen: press and hold for more than one second ▶ press ▶ press to select [宛先未設定] (No destination) ▶ press to enter the recipient's phone number ▶ press ▶ press to select [メッセージ未設定] (No message) ▶ press to enter your message ▶ press ▶ press .

- Reading a Received C-mail Message
When you receive a C-mail message, "新着CメールX件" (X New C-mail), where X represents the number of messages received, will be displayed on the stand-by screen.
From the stand-by screen: press to select [新着Cメール] (New C-mail) ▶ press ▶ press to select the C-mail message you want to read ▶ press .

Using EZweb

EZweb is an information service that allows you to enjoy easy Internet access from your mobile phone.
To use the EZweb service, you need to subscribe to the EZweb service. If you did not subscribe it when you purchased your phone, please contact au Customer Service Center or au shop for further information. Make sure that you set the default settings before using the E-mail and EZweb services for the first time. (See "Setting the E-mail/EZweb Default Settings" above.)
From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press ▶ select the website you want to view.

If the phone is closed
From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press to select [EZweb] ▶ press ▶ press to select [①トップメニュー] (①Top Menu) ▶ press to select the website you want to view.

Using the Camera (Movie Clips/Photos)

- Recording a Movie Clip
To record a movie clip: press for more than one second ▶ press to start recording the movie clip ▶ press to stop recording ▶ press to save the movie.

If the phone is closed
From the stand-by screen: press for more than one second ▶ press to start recording the movie clip ▶ press to stop recording ▶ press to save the movie.

- Taking a Photo
To take a photo: press ▶ press to take the photo ▶ press to save the photo.

If the phone is closed
From the stand-by screen: press ▶ press to take the photo ▶ press to save the photo.

Making an International Call

Ex: To call 212-123-△△△△ in the USA
 ▶ △△△△ ▶ Press

↑ International access code ↑ Country code (USA) ↑ Area code (USA) ↑ Phone number you want to call

Other Handy Features

- Manner Mode
From the stand-by screen: press and hold for more than one second.
To disable Manner mode, press and hold for more than one second from the stand-by screen.
- Setting the Voice Record Function
From the stand-by screen: press and hold for more than one second.
To disable the Voice Record function, press and hold for more than one second from the stand-by screen.
