

STEP 1 RECORD A VIDEO CLIP




If the image is not captured...


Is there enough power left in the battery? Recharge the battery pack.

(See "CHARGE THE BATTERY PACK" on the reverse side.) Is an SD Memory Card installed in the camera? Install a card.

STEP 2 CAPTURE A STILL IMAGE



You can capture a still image while recording a video clip.




To capture a single shot while recording, press the still image shooting button [].

 The scene at the time the still image shooting button was pressed is captured as a still image.


STEP 3 VIEWING IMAGES

Set the main switch to

PLAY.



STEP 4 ERASING IMAGES



Display the image that you want to erase.

Toggle the SET
 button up.
 The Confirm Erase
 Screen appears.

Select "YES", and press the SET button.


- The current image is erased.
- To return to the Playback Screen, select "EXIT", and press the SET button.

CHARGE THE BATTERY PACK

Use the supplied AC adaptor to charge the battery pack while it is installed in your camera.



CAMERA SHORTCUTS

Some of the camera functions can be accessed using the following shortcuts, as well as from the Setting Screen menus.

■Shooting mode

Adjust the monitor brightness:

Press and hold the MENU button for at least 1 second.

Instant review playback:

Press the SET button.

[] Adjust the exposure:

Toggle the SET button to the right.

[\] Change the focus range:

T ' " OFT' "

Toggle the SET button down.

For a second of

[AFa] Lock the focus:

Toggle the SET button up.

■Playback mode

Display the image properties:

Press the MENU button for about 1 second.

Erase an image:

Toggle the SET button up.
