Whether you are creating memories of your friends and family or exploring the great outdoors to get the utmost satisfaction from your DV, please take a moment to read through this manual. Its contents will send you on an educational journey into your camera's multiple capabilities.

#### 1. Camera Precaution

Before using the camera, please ensure that you read and understand the safety precautions described below. Always ensure that the camera is operated correctly.

- Never operate the camera inside of an aircraft or anywhere else where operation of such devices is restricted. Improper use creates the risk of serious accident.
- Do not aim the camera directly into the sun or other intense light sources which could damage your eyesight.
- Do not try to open the case of the camera or attempt to modify this camera in any way. High-voltage internal components create the risk of electric shock when exposed. Maintenance and repairs should be carried out only by authorized service providers.
- Do not fire the flash too close to the eyes of animals or people, especially for young children. Eye damage may result. In particular, remain at least one meter away from infants when using flash.

- Keep the camera away from water and other liquids.



# Installing the Battery Pack

- 1. Open the LCD monitor up.
- Open the battery cover by lightly pressing and sliding it.
- 3. Fit in the battery with its label facing upward and pay attention to the indicated polarity (+ and -).
- 4. After the battery is set, close the battery cover.




### Battery power status



## Charging the Battery Pack

The battery pack is not charged at the time of purchase and therefore need to be charged before use. If the battery charge becomes low while you are using the camera, it is recommended to recharge it as soon as possible.

- Insert the battery pack into the battery compartment of camera, pay attention to the indicated polarity (+ and -).
- 2. To connect the AC adaptor to a power outlet.
- When the battery pack is fully charged, the LED light is red become to green, remove it from the AC adaptor.




#### CAUTION

## Inserting the SD/MMC Card

- 1. Open the LCD monitor up.
- Open the battery cover by lightly pressing and sliding it.
- 3. Insert SD/MMC cart into memory card slot and push it all the way in.
- 4. Close the battery cover.




### When the optional SD card is installed:

- \* All images by default will be automatically stored in SD/MMC card
- \* With SD/MMC card installed, the video clips/ images/ audio clips in built-in memory cannot be played back. To playback the video clips/ images/ audio clips in built-in memory, remove SD/MMC card first.
- \* When you format camera, it would format the video clips/ images/ audio clips on SD card only. To format the video clips/ images/ audio clips which on built-in memory, remove SD card.

## Using the LCD Monitor


- 1. Open the LCD Monitor as shown and the same time the turn the camera power on.
- Adjust the LCD Monitor angle according to the desired recording/ playing angle. The LCD Monitor can rotate up to angle 270° maximum.



## Powering the camera ON/ OFF


#### Power ON

- Press the Power Button to turn on or open the LCD Monitor to turn on. The green LED light up indicate power is on.
- When the LCD Monitor has been activated, the camera is ready to use.




#### Power OFF

Press Mode Button to select Setting Mode and then press OK button to enter Setting Mode.




### Startup Screen

2. Press the Shutter Release Button to start recording.




