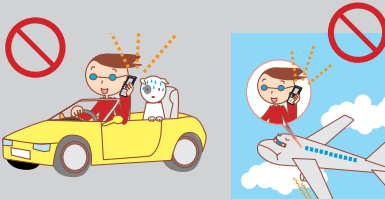

Manners for Using Cellphones

- A cellphone always generates weak electric waves while its power is ON.
- Be considerate of others and the environment around you, and have fun using your cellphone safely.

● In some places, the use of cellphones is prohibited.

- Do not use cellphones while you are driving. Doing so is dangerous and also forbidden by law.
- Be sure to turn your cellphone OFF before you board airplanes. The use of cellphones onboard airplanes is forbidden by law.



● Electric waves from cellphones may adversely influence medical devices and equipment.

- People with a pacemaker may be close to you in crowded places such as trains. Turn your cellphone OFF in such places.
- Abide by the instructions of hospitals and other medical institutions where it is forbidden to use or carry cellphones.



● Consider where to use your cellphone and be careful of how loudly you talk.

- Do not make calls in cinemas, theaters, museums, libraries and other similar places. Turn your cellphone OFF or set it to the manner mode to prevent others around you from being inconvenienced by ring tones for incoming calls or mail.



- When on a crowded street, use your cellphone in places where you do not prevent others from passing.
- When on a train or in a hotel lobby, move to areas where you will not bother others around you.
- Take care not to talk too loudly during conversations.



- Get permission from persons who will appear in photos or movies before you shoot photos or movies of others with your cellphone.

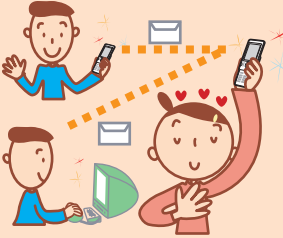

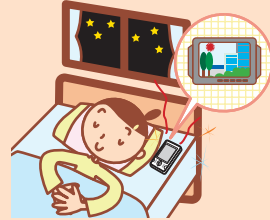

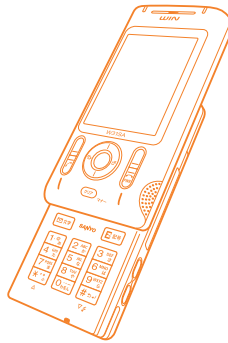

Useful Manner Mode and Answer Phone

■ Manner Mode

With Manner Mode, you can set the ringer not to sound so as not to bother the people around you.

Press  for more than one second while the standby screen is displayed.

The caller can leave a message when you cannot answer the phone.

Turn the Answer Phone ON.

Check the Power, Reception and Battery

■ Keep the “power” ON for normal use.

Keep the power ON to make or answer calls.

Not Using Your W31SA While Driving

■ Using your hands to make phone calls on a cellphone and/or watching the screen to view E-mails, etc., while driving shall be subject to penalties. (The implementation of the revised Road Traffic Law on November 1, 2004)

Turn the Power OFF or Set Drive Mode While Driving

■ Drive mode

By setting Drive mode, you will enable the caller to receive a response message such as “Now driving. I can’t answer the phone right now... (Japanese)” and store the caller’s message in the Answer Phone.

Press  while the standby screen is displayed, and select “Drive” → “Continuous Mode”.



Beware of Junk Mail and One-Ring Calls!

■ If you receive junk mail...

Using the mail filter function, you can reject mail sent from specific addresses or mail that bears “未承諾広告※(Unsolicited Ad)” in the title, which is the biggest source of junk mail.


The following mail functions are available for preventing arrival of junk mail.

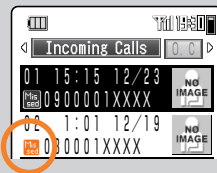
- “未承諾広告フィルター” : Rejects 未承諾広告 (Unsolicited Ad) mail.
- “アドレスフィルター” : Rejects mail sent from specified addresses.
- “指定受信設定” : Accepts only mails sent from specified addresses.
- “指定拒否設定” : Rejects mails sent from specified addresses.



■ If you receive a call from an unknown number...

It may be a “One-Ring Call” intended to trick you into calling back and accessing unwanted pay programs.


If a one-ring call is received,  (warm color) is displayed in the Incoming Calls.




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Making Key Operation Invalid

■ Making Key Operation Invalid

To carry the W31SA closed in your bag, press  (Main Menu) for more than one second while the standby screen is displayed to prevent key misoperation.

To Release from the Locked Status

Open the W31SA and press  (Main Menu) for more than one second while the standby screen is displayed.

Charging the Battery Pack

The battery pack is not fully charged at the time of purchase.

When you use the W31SA for the first time or when the battery level is low, charge the battery pack with the dedicated charger.

How to Charge the Battery Pack

Connect the SANYO AC Adapter 03 to the Desktop Holder.



Check the pin configuration and orientation of the connector before connecting the adapter.

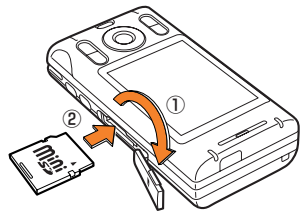
When opening the W31SA, slide the face containing the display upward until it clicks. When closing, carefully slide the face containing the display in the reverse direction.

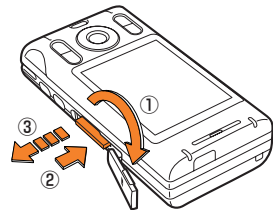

- ② Slightly push the miniSD Memory Card inward to release the lock.
- ③ The miniSD Memory Card will come out. Pull it out slowly and close the cover.

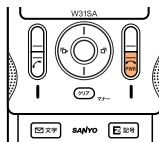

Using the Main Menu

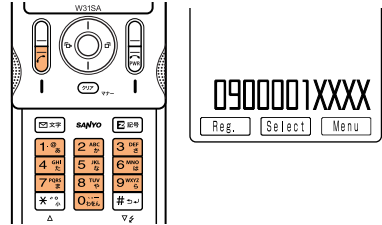


Making Calls

Add "186" before the phone number	Your phone number is displayed on the receiver's end.
Add nothing	The call is made in accordance with the Caller ID Notice setting.

Screen Displays for Incoming Phone Calls

Caller's phone number Example: "0900002XXXX"	The caller has set it so as to display his/her phone number. The caller's name is also displayed if the caller's information is registered in your address book.
"ID Unsent"	The caller has set it so as not to display his/her phone number.
"Payphone"	The call is made from a payphone.
"Not Support"	The call is made from the phone that does not support ID notification.

Screen Display if the Call Is Not Answered

The message shows that there were incoming calls unanswered (Missed calls).

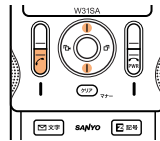

Countermeasure for One-Ring Calls

What Are One-Ring Calls?

One-Ring Calls is a trick used to milk money from cellphone users. The call is hung up after only 1 ring so as to be left in the Incoming Calls. Receivers who call back will access programs for which they must pay.


Icon as a Countermeasure for One-Ring Calls

With the W31SA, One-Ring Calls (ringer time is 3 seconds or less) are indicated by (warm color) in the Incoming Calls. Be careful if you are not familiar with any phone numbers that are indicated this way.

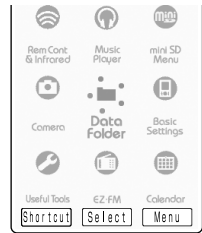
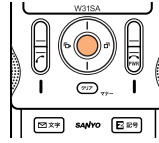

- Answer Phone can record for approximately 20 seconds maximum for each message, and up to 3 messages can be recorded including Rec.Phone Memo.
- Even when Answer Phone is turned OFF, the caller’s message can be recorded by pressing **●** () when a call is being received. (This action does not turn the Answer Phone ON.)
- Use “Voice Mail” when you have turned the power off or where electric waves are blocked.

Other Features

The W31SA is provided with other useful features.

Music Player

You can enjoy Chaku-Uta-Full™ and songs based on the SD-Audio standard as BGM while connecting to EZweb and creating a mail message.

Hands-free Call

You can call without holding the W31SA. You will hear the other party's voice from the speaker.

Remote Auto Lock

You can remotely set Auto Lock from a different telephone, which is registered in advance, to prevent another person from using your W31SA if you misplace or lose it.
