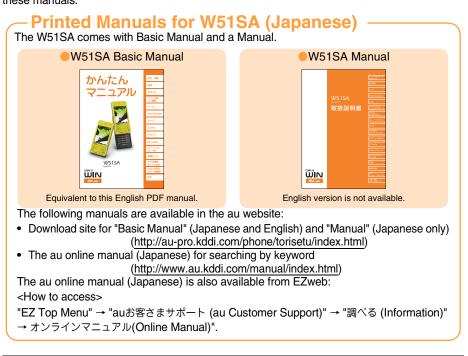

Manners for Using Cellphones

A cellphone always generates weak electric waves while its power is ON.
 Be considerate of others around you to use your cellphone enjoyably and safely.

In some places, the use of cellphones is prohibited.

- Using cellphones while driving is dangerous and also forbidden by the law.
- Be sure to turn your cellphone OFF before you board airplanes. The use of cellphones onboard airplanes is forbidden by the law.



Electric waves from cellphones may adversely influence medical devices and equipment.

- There may be someone with a pacemaker around you in crowded places such as trains. Turn your cellphone OFF in such places.
- Follow the instructions of hospitals and other medical institutions where it is forbidden to use or carry cellphones.



Consider where to use your cellphone and be careful of the volume of your voice.

 Do not make calls in cinemas, theaters, museums, libraries and other similar places. Turn your cellphone OFF or set it to the manner mode to prevent others around you from being inconvenienced by ring tones for incoming calls or mails.



- When on a crowded street, use your cellphone in places where you do not prevent others from passing.
- When on a train or in a hotel lobby, move to an area where you will not bother others around you.
- Take care not to talk too loudly during conversations.



• When you shoot photos or movies of others with your cellphone, get permission from them.

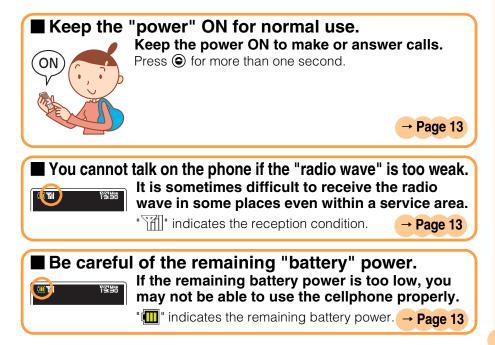

By setting Drive mode, you will enable the caller to hear a response message such as "Now driving. I cannot answer the phone right now...(Japanese)", and to store a message in Answer Phone.

Beware of Junk Mails and One-ring Calls!

If you receive junk mails...

Using the mail filter function, you can reject mails sent from specific addresses or mails that bear "未承諾広告※(Unsolicited Ad)" in the title, which is the biggest source of junk mails.

The following mail functions are available for preventing arrival of junk mails.

- "未承諾広告フィルター": Rejects "未承 諾広告 (Unsolicited Ad) mails.
- "アドレスフィルター": Řejects mails sent from specified addresses.
 - "指定受信設定": Accepts only mails sent from specified addresses.
 - "指定拒否設定": Rejects mails sent from specified addresses.



■ If you receive calls from unknown numbers... It may be "One-ring Calls" intended to trick you into calling back and accessing unwanted pay programs.

If One-ring Calls are received, Mis appears in Incoming Calls.

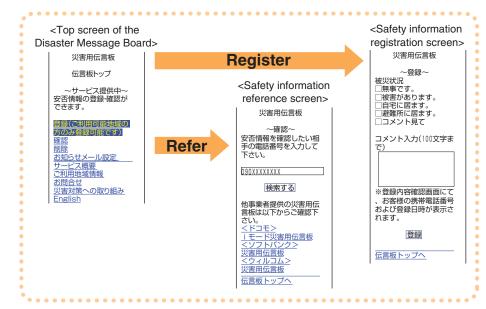

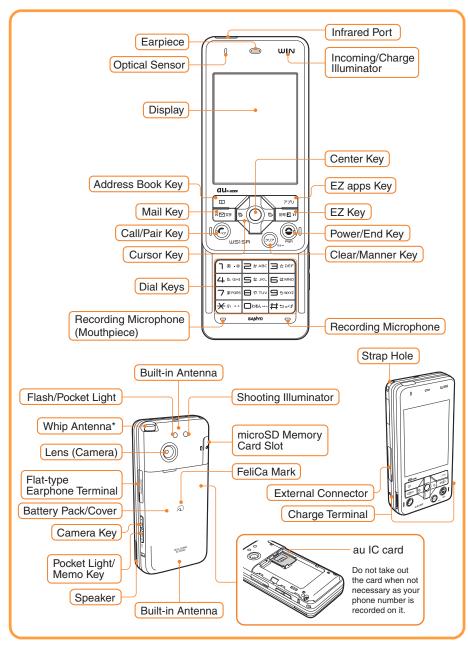

How to Charge the Battery Pack

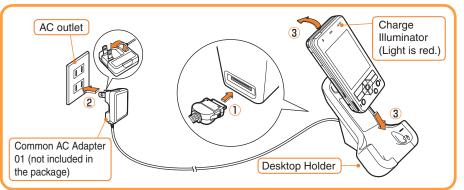
Connect the Common AC Adapter 01 to Desktop holder.

Check the pin configuration and orientation of the connector and connect it horizontally.

Plug the power plug of the Common AC Adapter 01 into an AC outlet.

Place the W51SA with the battery pack attached on Desktop holder, as illustrated below.

Hold Desktop holder to detach the W51SA.



- The cellphone beeps and the charge illuminator lights red. \rightarrow Charging is in progress.
- The cellphone beeps and the charge illuminator turns off. → Charging is completed.

- The battery pack can also be charged by directly inserting the Common AC Adapter 01 connector (not included in the package) into the external connector on the W51SA.
- Note that the actual figures may differ from the illustrations depending on your AC adapter.

The message shows that there were incoming calls unanswered (Missed Calls).

Countermeasure for One-ring Calls

What is One-ring Calls?

One-ring Calls is made to leave the number in Incoming Calls, and receivers who call back will be automatically connected to high-charged programs such as dating service.

Icon as Countermeasure for One-ring Calls

On the W51SA, One-ring Calls (the ringer time is 3 seconds or less) are displayed as Min in Incoming Calls. Be careful when you call back to an unfamiliar number.

Icons displayed on Incoming Calls

- Example: Missed calls of which ring time is 3 seconds or less
- Seconds : Missed calls of which ring time exceeds 3 seconds



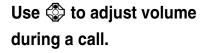

EZ FeliCa

EZ FeliCa is a service that allows you to use a cellphone that has the built-in contactless IC card technology known as "FeliCa". By simply holding the W51SA up to a Reader/Writer (external device)*, your phone can be used for shopping with a credit card and/or e-money, as a members' card, point card, and for receiving coupon information. In order to use EZ FeliCa, it is necessary to download the application of the company offering the service that you want to use. 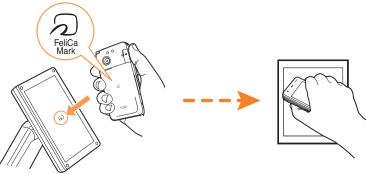

 The FeliCa Lock will be reactivated when you press local for more than one second or once the "Unlock for" is reached (set to 5 min. at the time of purchase).

Using FeliCa-supported EZ apps

FeliCa-supported "QUICPay $(\mathcal{P}\mathcal{A} \lor \mathcal{P}\mathcal{A}\mathcal{A})$ " apps are preinstalled in your W51SA.

Starting up FeliCa-supported EZ apps

Using au Mobile Coupons

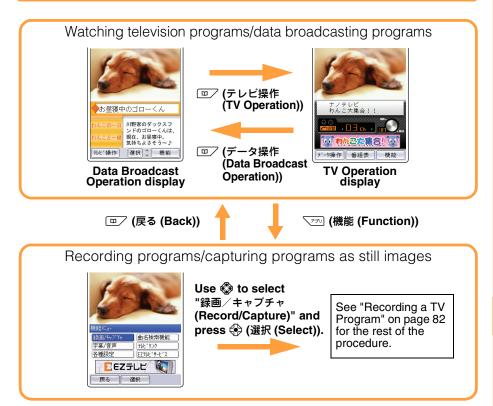

EZ Television (1Seg)

You can watch the Digital Terrestrial Broadcasting for Mobile Television Service "1Seg" with W51SA. (Broadcasting within Japan is only available.) In addition to the television programs, you can enjoy data broadcasting programs.

What You Can Do with EZ Television (1Seg)



Digital Terrestrial Broadcasting

1Seg is a service that uses a part of the radio wave of Digital Terrestrial Broadcasting and enables you to watch TV or data broadcasting programs with cellphones or other mobile devices, in the same way as watching them at home.

This service is called One-segment broadcasting (1Seg) since the 6MHz wave range of Digital Terrestrial Broadcasting is divided into 13 segments, to use one of them for the broadcasting.

Before Using EZ Television (1Seg)

- Perform initialization before using the service. If you have not performed initialization yet, see page 17.
- Any fee for packet or other transmission is not charged when watching EZ Television (1Seg). However, you are charged for packet communication if you access the services such as Program Information or Information Window.
- Any fee for packet or other transmission is not charged when watching data broadcasting programs for EZ Television (1Seg). However, you are charged for packet communication if you use the interactive service provided on data broadcasting programs or access the information sites of EZweb.
- EZ Television (1Seg) is not available after you terminate the use of your W51SA.
- When the battery level is ", EZ Television (1Seg) cannot be activated. If the battery level changes to ", during use of EZ Television (1Seg), EZ Television ends automatically.
- The duration available for viewing with the W51SA* is approximately 5 hours and 5 minutes (DBEX OFF)/4 hours and 55 minutes (DBEX ON). It is subject to change due to the operation of the data broadcasting. * When outputting from the earphone
- Deteriorated image, poor image or sound quality or reception failure may occur in mountainous areas, near buildings, in underpasses, in tunnels, or indoors because of poor TV reception. Try the following to improve the reception of the radio wave:
 - \cdot Extend the W51SA Antenna (for EZ Television (1Seg)/EZ \cdot FM) to locate the direction for the best reception.
- When you are indoors, take your W51SA as close to a window as possible.
 1Seg has been introduced in Tokyo/Nagoya/Osaka and some other

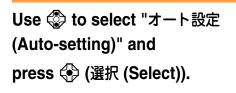

It may be difficult to properly set channels when you first start using the "1Seg" Digital Terrestrial Broadcasting for Mobile Television Service.

Information •

- When starting up EZ Television (1Seg), a characteristic of Digital Broadcasts in which it can take some time to receive images, and especially Data Broadcast data, may appear.
- After starting up EZ Television (1Seg) the first time, the channel last selected during the previous use will be displayed. If you have moved to a different area or are in an area with poor reception, you will need to reset the channel(s).

This setting is set to " $\neg - \lor$ (Auto)" (switch sound output automatically to either the earphones or speaker depending upon whether earphones are attached or not) at the time of purchase.

Information

- Videos are saved in the "EZ Television" folder within either the Data folder or the SD-Video folder. Still images are saved in the "Graphics" folder within the Data folder.
- Recording may not be possible if there is insufficient space left in the Data folder.
- The amount of recording time possible will differ depending upon the amount of space remaining in the Data folder or microSD card, as well as depending upon the content of the program being recorded (volume of the Data Broadcast data, etc.). The maximum amount of recording time possible is approximately 5 hours when saved to the cellphone's Data folder and approximately 10 hours when saved to a 2-GB microSD card.
- The titles of recordings saved are displayed as the "(program name at the start of recording)" plus "(date at the start of recording)". The titles of still images saved are displayed as "DTV)" plus "(date started)" plus "(time started)" plus "(serial number)".
- Recorded TV programs and saved still images are saved with copyright protection and it is not possible to attaching them to E-mails or copy and/ or transfer them to external devices. It is also not possible to register them for use as the standby screen, etc.

Ending EZ Television (1Seg)

Press (2). Use (3) to select "End" and press (4) (OK).



EZ · FM

You can listen to FM radio with your W51SA. The audio on the FM radio can be recorded.

Antenna Available for W51SA

To listen to EZ · FM, use the antenna for optimal reception of airwaves. The reception antenna when listening to EZ · FM will be as follows.

Remote Ctrl Lock

In Case You Lose Your W51SA

The Remote Ctrl Lock function enables you to turn ON the Auto Lock, FeliCa Lock and Address Book Restriction functions through remote operation so that no one else can use your W51SA.

Setting Remote Ctrl Lock Activation Conditions

The Auto Lock, FeliCa Lock and Address Book Restriction functions are activated when your W51SA receives the specified number of calls from the registered phone number within the specified period of time.

 - Incm Call Ct: Sets the number of incoming calls required for activating Remote Auto Lock.

The count can be set between 3 and 10 times.

Remotely Activating the Auto Lock, FeliCa Lock and Address Book Restriction Functions on the W51SA

Call your W51SA in the conditions set for Remote Ctrl Lock.

Remote Ctrl Lock is activated and an announcement to that effect will be played once the specified number of calls is received from the registered phone number within the specified period of time.

Activating the Lock through the Security Lock Service

Even if you have not set the Remote Ctrl Lock in advance, the Security Lock Service gives you the ability to turn ON the Auto Lock, FeliCa Lock and Address Book Restriction functions remotely by calling the au Customer Center or performing a specified procedure from a PC. This service is available free of charge.

Using the Security Lock Service

• Turning Remote Ctrl Lock ON/OFF by calling the au Customer Center From au cellphones: 113 area code not required (Toll-Free) From cellphones except au, or regular phones: 10077-7-113 (Toll-Free)

Hours: 24 hours a day

Turning Remote Ctrl Lock ON/OFF using a PC Login to MyKDDI (http://my.kddi.com/) and perform the procedure indicated on-screen.

* It is necessary to apply for this service before using it for the first time. (Application is possible even after you may have lost your phone.)

Information

- Remote Ctrl Lock cannot be activated if your W51SA is not powered on or under an area with bad reception, or Emission OFF is set to "Valid".
- "Erase Data" and "Unlock Phone" are both set to "Invalid" at the time of purchase.
- The Security Lock Service is scheduled to be available starting from March 2007.

Other Features

W51SA is provided with other useful features.

Global Expert

The W51SA supports Global Expert function using au IC card. Global Expert is an international roaming service that allows you to connect to the world by simply inserting your au IC card into a GSM mobile phone for overseas use. No special application or daily/monthly charges are needed. Charges for overseas calls are billed together with monthly domestic calling charges.

au My Page

This service saves the data that is on your W51SA, enabling you to backup the contents of your address book, your E-mail, and your Data folder.

EZ News Flash

This information delivery service enables you to check the news and weather, etc., on the standby screen.

FM Transmitter

This feature enables you to transmit the sound from the au Music Player, SD-Audio Player and Video Player using the FM radio band, and then receive and play that sound using the FM tuner in your home stereo system or car stereo, etc.

PC Site Viewer

This feature enables you to view Internet Web Sites created for display on PCs.

microSD[™] Memory Card (Commercially Available)

You can keep various data on a microSD[™] Memory Card (commercially available).

Decoration Mail

You can send a decorated E-mail with various font colors, font sizes or templates to a cellphone which supports the function.

au Music Port

Music data downloaded from au Music Port or purchased at LISMO Music Store can be transferred to your W51SA. You can also edit the address book or schedule in your W51SA, or keep and manage the photo or movie data in your PC, which were shot with your W51SA.

Ugomoji Mail™

You can enjoy displaying pictographs or texts in sent/received E-mails as animation.

Quiz Training

You can enjoy 3 mini games such as "Number Quiz", "Sound Quiz" or "English Quiz".
